## Study Tips

- Do a little EVERYDAY
- Don't wait until the night (or two) before
- Find a location free of distractions
  - Turn OFF cell phone
- Keep a record of all tests, projects, and homework.
  - You can't do it if you don't know it's due

## Study Tips

- Take accurate notes.
- Make sure you have reviewed earlier notes.
- Make vocabulary flash cards
  - Have someone quiz you
- Create concept maps
  - Can you link the important topics together?

## Using the Book

- Start with the pictures, tables, and graphs.
  - Look at it. Do you understand what it is showing?
  - Read the caption. Do you understand what it says?



## Using the Book

- Know the vocabulary
  - If it's bold – learn it.
  - If it's italicized – learn it.
  - If it's in a picture/graph/table – learn it.



## Using the Book



- Reading (Ugh!)
  - Start with the title – what’s the chapter about?
  - How is the chapter divided?
    - What are the titles of each section?
    - What are they about?
    - Do you know the vocabulary (LOOK IT UP!)
  - How is each section divided?
    - Look at the bold headings in each section.
    - Do you know the vocabulary (LOOK IT UP!)

## Using the Book



- Reading (Ugh!)
  - Break it into small pieces
    - 4-6 pages
    - Avoids overload
    - Allows absorption
  - Summarize what you have read
    - What do you remember?
    - Vocabulary
  - Reread to make sure you didn’t leave anything out.

## What do I do with this Study Guide



- Answer the questions – Duh!
  - Don’t use your notes or the book.
  - Answer what you can remember without looking
  - Check your work
  - Look up what you got wrong/didn’t know.
  - Do it again
- Don’t use 1-2 word answers. ELABORATE!

## Multiple Choice



- Think before you bubble.
- Read the question before you look at the answer choices.
- Come up with the answer in your head before looking at the possible answers.
- Eliminate answers you know aren't right.
- Read all the choices before choosing your answer.
